Tools Required

- Socket Wrench with Extension
- 3/4", 12mm, & 19mm Sockets
- 3/4", 12mm Box End Wrench
- Flat and Phillips Head Screw Drivers
- Floor Jack and wood block.

II. Removal of Stock Bumper

A. Using a Phillips head screw driver remove the license plate lights from each side of the OEM bumper. Disconnect the harness on the back side of the light to remove fully. Secure the harness out of harms way to the frame.

- B. Remove your license plate from the OEM Bumper.
- C. Remove the plastic corner pieces from the top of the OEM bumper by pulling up from the outside edge. If the plastic is being stubborn during removal the plastic clips can be popped loose from the bottom side of the bumper. See Image Below.

D. Remove the Phillips head screw passing through the plastic that was hidden by the license plate previously. See Image Below.



E. Pop the plastic clips loose on the bottom side of the main piece of plastic on the top side of the bumper allowing access to the OEM fasteners.

F. Using a 12mm wrench remove the eight OEM fasteners holding the OEM bumper shell to the receiver hitch.

G. Remove the OEM bumper and set aside. Hold onto the OE Hardware. You will need it to install your Fab Fours bumper.

H. Your Truck is now ready for the installation of your new Fab Fours Rear Bumper!

III.Rear Bumper Installation

NOTE: The Following Installation steps apply to the installation of the Rear Bumper. PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE MANUAL BEFORE ATEMPTING INSTALLATION! Ignoring these steps will increase your probability of scratching the vehicle during product Installation!

- A. Remove the Bumper from the shipping carton. Lay all items out on a blanket to prevent damage to the powder coating.
- B. Using a 19mm socket and wrench to remove the three bolts from each side of the hitch frame plate.
- C. Using the OE Hardware install the supplied intermediate mounting brackets to the hitch frame plate. Complete on both driver and passenger sides of vehicle. Do Not Fully Tighten, Finger Tighten Only. See Image Below.




D. With the help of two friends and possibly a floor jack to help support the center of the bumper lift the Fab Fours bumper into place.

E. With the bumper held into place insert the supplied ½" fasteners through the bumper and into the bumper brackets placing the nuts on the front side of the frame mount. Do Not Fully Tighten. See Image Below.

- F. Align the bumper side to side and top to bottom to ensure a perfect fit to the truck. Allow for a 0.5" clearance to all painted surfaces if possible to allow for frame flex.
- G. Check that the tailgate does not interfere with the bumper by opening it very carefully and lowering it into place. If tailgate is to close to the bumper, adjust bumper lower.
- H. Fully tighten all fasteners between bumper and brackets and brackets and frame.
- I. Install OEM license plate light using supplied black machine screws and install light and plug back into back side of the light housing.
- J. Install supplied license plate plastic nut inserts and


