## Flaming River Industries 1965-1966 Power Steering Control Valve FR1497VLV



## Removal:

- **1)** Mark the location and remove the four fluid lines from the control valve.
- **2)** Rotate the wheels back and forth several times to evacuate the remaining fluid from the system.
- **3)** Remove the power steering cylinder stud from the drag link.
- **4)** Remove pitman arm, idler arm and inner tie rod ends from drag link. Then remove link from car.

## Installation:

- 1) Place drag link in car, and install inner tie rod ends, idler arm and the pitman arm to the valve ball stud. <u>Make sure to install all new cotter pins.</u>
- 2) Install and tighten all the fluid lines in to there proper position making sure not to over tighten the fittings.
- 3) Fill with the reservoir with new power steering fluid to the proper level.
- **4)** Run vehicle for a few minutes to warm fluid, and then turn the steering wheel back and forth several times reaching the stops each way. Check the system for leaks.
- 5) Recheck fluid and fill if necessary.
- 6) Run vehicle increasing RPM's to 1000 turning wheel back and forth several times reaching the stops each way. Recheck system for leaks.
- 7) Recheck fluid and fill in necessary.
- 8) With engine running and wheels straight ahead check the position of the steering wheels. <u>Note:</u> Front end alignment may be necessary after installation.
