<u>Step 1:</u>. Remove two top factory bumper bolts. (Note: <u>Do not</u> remove factory bumper). Install Frontier bumper support bracket behind bumper and bolt to the frame hole that you just removed the factory bolt from. Re-install Factory bolt and tighten. (Hint – Brackets should fit snug against the back of the chrome bumper.

<u>Step 2:</u> Hold Grille Guard up to truck and measure loops to body and position grille guard evenly. Mark holes on bumper that you will drill next.

Step 3: Align grille guard to truck and drill 1/2 inch hole through chrome bumper and bumper support bracket installed in step 1. Step 4: Insert 1/2 X 1-3/4 inch bolts through grille guard, chrome bumper, and bumper support bracket.

<u>Step 5:</u> Remove outside tow hook bolt and Insert bottom of Grille Guard to the **outside of the frame** (tow hook hole). Re-Install tow hook bolt on both feet.

Step 6: Check alignment of grille guard to truck and tighten all bolts.
