

G Body Notes: PLEASE READ PRIOR TO SELECTING YOUR <u>G BODY CROSSMEMBER</u> TO ENSURE PROPER FITMENT OF THE PART.

NOTE: Some 1983 Hurst Olds were delivered from the factory with the 2004R transmission. These 1983 models do not need a frame extension to run the longer transmission series crossmembers. (The early frame configuration as seen on most 78-83 vehicles has one location to bolt the transmission crossmember on the driver side frame rail, which is in relative close proximity to the driver's door hinge. The late frame configuration as seen on most 84-88 vehicles has two locations to bolt the transmission crossmember on the driver side frame rail, with the second location approximately 14" rearward of the front set.)

NOTE: Some 1984 El Camino's were delivered from the factory with the early style frame configuration, and WILL NEED a FE-100 Frame Extension to run the longer transmission series crossmembers. (The early frame configuration as seen on most 78-83 vehicles has one location to bolt the transmission crossmember on the driver side frame rail, which is in relative close proximity to the driver's door hinge. The late frame configuration as seen on most 84-88 vehicles has two locations to bolt the transmission crossmember on the driver side frame rail, with the second location approximately 14" rearward of the front set.)
