


Read the assembly and installation instructions completely and verify that all of the parts listed are accounted for.


INSTALLATION


Step-1 Located holes inside the body in vehicle, front, middle, rear, place a clip nut in upper part. SEE ILLUSTRATION 1 & 2.

Step-2 Mount bracket and attach with: 3/8 x 1 1/4" hex head bolt, 3/8" flat and lock washers, in lower part attach with: 3/8 x 1 1/4" hex head bolt, 3/8 flat washer, 3/8" lock washer, 3/8" hex nut. SEE ILLUSTRATION 3. By each bracket. Leave loose.



Step-3 Place the U bracket and attach with: 5/16" hex head bolt, 5/16" Flat and lock washer (black plated), by each bracket. SEE ILLUSTRATION 4 & 5. Repeat for the opposite side. Leave loose.





Use ratchet & 1/2" hex socket or 1/2" wrench.

Step-4 Align the side step and then tighten all bolts.

Step-5 Periodically check your product because it may need a re-tighten of bolts.

Step-6 Fill the warranty card and place it inside your vehicle's glove box.
