

ASSEMBLY & INSTALLATION TOOLS REQUIRED:

1/2" Socket & 1/2" Wrench

13mm Socket & 13mm Wrench

Ratchet

Read the assembly and installation instructions completely and verify that all of the parts listed are accounted for.


It is the customer's responsibility to protect the finish with a regular application of a nonabrasive polish compatible with the products finish. **NOTE: LOOK THE POSITION BEFORE INSTALLING THE BRACKETS.**

INSTALLATION


Step-1 Locate at the front, middle and rear of the rocker panel the threaded studs as shown in PICTURES 1 & 2.


Step-2 Place the bracket on the threaded studs and attach with: (1) 5/16" flat and lock washer (gray), (1) M8 hex nut (gray), by each threaded stud. Look ILLUSTRATION 1. Leave loose. Repeat for each bracket.





Step-3 Place the U bracket and attach with: 5/16" hex head bolt (black), 5/16" Flat and lock washer (black), by each bracket. **SEE ILLUSTRATION 3 & 4.** Repeat for the opposite side. Leave loose.





Use ratchet & 1/2" hex socket.

Step-4 Align the side bar and then tighten all bolts.

Step-5 Periodically check your product because it may need a re-tighten of bolts.

Step-6 Fill the warranty card and place it inside your vehicle's glove box.
