
Component installation

behind door panel Vehicles that have premium sound systems will often have separate tweeters in a dash or door location. Try to use this location for mounting the component tweeter if possible.






B Custom location

If there is not a suitable factory location for woofer or tweeter to be mounted, custom mounting may be necessary. Before making any permanent changes to your vehicle make sure there is adequate mounting depth.



C Tweeter mounting There are two primary ways the tweeter can be mounted. Surface and Flush mounting. The flush mount configuration is shown here.




D Crossover wiring

The crossover is necessary for the proper operation of the component speaker system. Secure the crossover to a surface that is free of interference from window mechanisms and excessive moisture.



Always consider consulting a professional audio installer before installing new speakers. Many car manufacturers locate speakers behind interior panels that require special tools to remove those panels to access the speakers. Some panels will be screwed in, some will use plastic fasteners, many will have both. Be careful and take your time. If you are using the speaker wire supplied with your new speakers make sure that you run the speaker wires through the factory boot. Do not let speaker wire make contact with metal edges of doors or other access holes.




Factory Speaker Removal
