# Jeep Wrangler Spare Tire Adapter/Spacer

## PRE-INSTALLATION

#### **NOTES:**

Intended for tires up to 33"x12.50 - larger tires may damage rear gate. Check hardware regularly to ensure tightness.

#### **REQUIRED TOOLS:**

3/4" Socket 3/4" Wrench

# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- STEP 1: Remove spare tire (3/4" socket).
- STEP 2: Install studs in spacer bracket, matching factory bolt pattern.
- STEP 3: Use non-locking nut and 9/16" flat washer to fully tighten each stud (impact wrench and 3/4" socket).
- STEP 4: Remove non-locking nut and washer and discard.
- STEP 5: Install spare tire bracket on factory studs. Secure with supplied lock-nuts and washers (3/4" wrench).
- STEP 6: Re-install spare tire.
- STEP 7: Re-install factory lug nuts and tighten (3/4" socket).

## POST-INSTALLATION

#### **MAINTENANCE:**

Re-tighten lug nuts after 500 Miles.

Wheel lug nuts should be re-tightened to factory torque specs. periodically. Always inspect components and re-tighten lug nuts during routine service.
