

Trailer Hitch Wiring & Electrical



- harness will have the same connector end as the Wiring Kit. The most common location is 6" behind the rear bumper near the center of the vehicle.
- Remove protective cap (not required on all installations) from the vehicle taillight wiring harness. Connectors will disconnect by pressing or lifting on a locking tab and pulling apart.
- Apply a small amount of grease to all electrical connections to help prevent corrosion.
- Plug Wiring Kit (B) into mating vehicle plug. Be sure the connectors are fully inserted with locking tabs in place.
- Plug completed wire harness (C) into the trailer connector.
- Test all functions with engine running to ensure proper operation.

TIPS:

- Grease applied to the trailer wiring terminals on a regular basis will help prevent corrosion.
 A heavy duty flasher may be required to eliminate
- rapid flashing.
- Always unplug boat trailer connector before backing trailer into the water.
