Thank you for selecting a WeatherBeater® Floor Liner from Winfield Consumer Products. Your new front floor liners are custom molded to fit your Toyota Prius. The liners are made to take the place of your factory floor mats. *For correct fit, it is necessary to remove the factory floor mats before installing your new floor liners*. However, do not remove the factory-installed carpeting.

Your liners are made from an engineering resin that is lightweight and extremely tough and durable. The easiest way to clean your liners is with a damp cloth or sponge. If using a cleaner, 409[®] or Glass Plus[®] work well. Use of Armor All[®], Son-of-a-Gun[®] or similar items is discouraged as these products make the liners slick.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUR TOYOTA PRIUS FRONT WeatherBeater® FLOOR LINERS



LEFT OR DRIVER'S SIDE



RIGHT OR PASSENGER'S SIDE

TO EASE INSTALLATION OF YOUR FRONT FLOOR LINERS, MOVE THE FRONT SEATS TO THEIR REAR MOST POSITION. WITH THIS DONE, REMOVE THE FACTORY CARPET HOOKS FROM THE DRIVER'S SIDE FLOOR PAN (SEE INSTRUCTIONS ON BACK OF PAGE). YOUR HUSKY LINERS COME WITH A REPLACEMENT RETAINING CLIP THAT WILL SECURE YOUR LINER USING THE EXISTING FACTORY CARPET HOOK LOCATIONS. SEE INSTALLATION PHOTOS / INSTRUCTIONS ARE ON THE BACK OF PAGE.

AS IT IS BOXED, YOUR DRIVER'S SIDE LINER COVERS THE FUEL DOOR RELEASE LEVER. TO ACCESS THE RELEASE LEVER YOU CAN SIMPLY JUST LIFT UP THE LINER, OR, YOU CAN TRIM AWAY THE LOWERED AREA ON THE LINER LOCATED DIRECTLY ABOVE THE RELEASE LEVER. TO TRIM, USE THE EDGES OF THE RECESSED AREA AS YOUR GUIDE. THE DIAGRAM ABOVE SHOWS THE AREA TRIMMED.



FRONT OF VEHICLE




TO EASE INSTALLATION OF YOUR PRIUS SECOND SEAT LINER, MOVE THE FRONT SEATS TO THEIR MOST FORWARD POSITION. WITH THIS DONE, INSTALL LINER IN VEHICLE. ONCE LINER IS IN PLACE, REPOSITION THE FRONT SEATS AS NEEDED.


YOUR NEW HUSKY® FLOOR LINER SET INCLUDES OUR NEW PATENT PENDING FLOOR LINER RETAINING CLIP SYSTEM. THIS RETAINING CLIP GIVES THE EXTRA SECURITY PROVIDED BY AN OEM STYLE FASTENER WHILE KEEPING SPILLS AND DEBRIS TRAPPED INSIDE THE LINERS. TO INSTALL THE HUSKY® LINER RETAINING CLIPS, SIMPLY FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW:

1) REMOVE THE EXISTING FACTORY MAT HOOK AS SHOWN IN IMAGE 1 AND IMAGE 2 BELOW. MODERATE EFFORT IS REQUIRED TO POP THE FACTORY HOOKS OUT. NEWER GENERATIONS OF THE FACTORY HOOK HAVE A CENTER SPREADER THAT MUST FIRST BE REMOVED BEFORE THE HOOK WILL RELEASE. SEE IMAGES 3 AND 4 BELOW. ONCE THE SPREADER IS REMOVED, THE HOOK WILL POP OUT JUST AS WITH THE OLDER STYLE HOOKS.











2) WITH THE FACTORY CLIPS REMOVED, UNSCREW THE TWO HALVES OF THE HUSKY® RETAINING CLIP AND INSERT THE BOTTOM HALF INTO THE EXISTING FACTORY GROMMETS LOCATION AS SHOWN

BELOW IN IMAGE 4 AND IMAGE 5. THE BOTTOM PORTION WILL "SNAP" SECURELY INTO THE FACTORY GROMMET LOCATION. RETAIN THE TOP HALF OF THE CLIP FOR LATER INSTALLATION.





3) NOW THAT YOU HAVE THE BOTTOM PORTION OF THE RETAINING CLIPS INSTALLED, PLACE THE LINER IN THE VEHICLE TAKING CARE TO ALIGN THE HOLES IN THE LINER WITH THE THREADED PORTION OF THE BOTTOM RETAINING CLIPS AS SHOWN IN IMAGE 5 BELOW. LASTLY, SCREW THE TOP HALF OF THE RETAINING CLIPS ONTO THE TREADED POST OF THE BOTTOM PORTION, SECURING THE LINER IN PLACE AS SHOWN IN IMAGE 6.
