

LOOSE FIT ALL COMPONENTS. DO NOT TIGHTEN UNTIL ALL COMPONENTS ARE INSTALLED AND ADJUSTED.



- STEP 1. First step before you begin, open up all packaging and remove the hardware package and inspect it for completeness. Read instructions completely and make sure you understand the installation.
- STEP 2. Open hood of vehicle and disconnect negative battery terminal.
- STEP 3. Begin by removing the factory grille assembly. Remove and save the four 10mm hex head bolts attaching the upper tabs to the core support mounts. Lift up gently on the tabs and pull outward toward the front of the truck. Release the lower spring clips tabbed in near the bottom inner sides of the grille and remove the grille. Set aside for re-installation later on after removal of the factory bumper.
- STEP 4. Next unplug the fog lamp plug from the rear of the lamp assembly (if so equipped). Also remove the retaining clip attaching the wiring harness to the inside bumper support bracket. Unplug parking sensor harness (if so equipped), leave sensors in bumper until after removal.
- STEP 5. Next unbolt the lower valance from underneath the front bumper. Remove the four hex head screws and the two plastic push tabs and let the valance hang down freely.
- Now remove the intermediate cross brace located behind the bumper and in front of the radiator. Remove the five hex head nuts and put aside to be reinstalled later. STEP 6.
- STEP 7. Now remove the factory bumper by unbolting the eight 14mm hex head nuts (4 per side) attaching the bumper to the frame, save for reuse with the FBM25/54/62/89TYN Magnum bumper. Once all bumper hardware has been removed slide the bumper off of the study away from the vehicle and set aside.
- STEP 8. Begin installation of the FBM25/54/62/89TYN Magnum Bumper by installing the BP5182 brackets onto the factory frame bumper mounting location utilizing the factory 14mm hex head nuts removed in the previous step. Align brackets making sure they are level, then snug the factory nuts down but do not fully tighten until after the bumper has been installed and adjusted. Remove factory parking sensors (if equipped) from the stock bumper. Remove retaining clip from the backside of the bumper and slide sensor out through the front of the bumper. Transfer over to the new MAGNUM Bumper reusing the factory mounting hardware in the reverse order in which they were removed.
- STEP 9. On the new Magnum Bumper, install the four BP5186 T-Bolts into the bumper inside mounting brackets and attach using the supplied plastic push nuts. Now with help, lift and support the bumper. Carefully slide the bumper onto the BP5182 brackets on the frame and align the T-Bolts with the slots in the brackets. Attach using the supplied M12 flat washers, lock washers, and hex head nuts. Carefully align the bumper from side to side and up and down. Once you are satisfied with the fit tighten all M12 hardware. Next fully tighten the eight factory 14mm hex head nuts to the frame. Plug in parking sensor harness into sensors and check for proper function.
- **STEP 10.** If you have purchased the SKIDPO6TY (Optional Skid Plate) install that now using all factory skid plate hardware. If you are installing lights into your new bumper, do so now into the mounting tab locations provided in the bumper and wire to the manufactures specifications. ICI recommends that you re-torque all mounting hardware after 50-100 miles of driving. Enjoy your new MAGNUM BUMPER!
