

IN-AD IN-SD IN-MD Basic Carrier System Installation Instructions



Care and Storage

- Wash any mud off the carrier system. Use a damp towel to wipe away dust and dirt. Do not use any thinner or solvents to clean any part of the carrier system.
- After cleaning carrier, check for any of the following:
 - 1) Worn screw threads
- 2) Key deformation
- 3) Holder deformation
- 4) Cracks in any of the components of the carrier


Store all components of the carrier system together in one place to prevent any component from being lost. Avoid storage in areas subject to direct sunlight, high temperature or excessive humidity.








1 Place pre-assembled carriers on roof at desired positions.












How to use lock wrench/nut

- 1 With carrier installed, check if knob is securely tightened.
- ② Loosely install lock nut onto bolt by hand. Pay attention to orientation of nut.
- 3 Apply lock wrench to nut and turn clockwise to tighten securely.
- 4 Verify knob doest not turn by hand.




Einno. Guidelines for Using the Carrier System




Before using the Carrier System, carefully read these guidelines as well as the installation and usage instructions for all the components that make up the carrier system.

After reading these guidelines, keep them in a safe place with the instructions for the rest of the carrier system. If you give the Carrier System to a third person, provide this manual to ensure safe installation and usage.

Precautions



The carrier system's compatibility with an automobile is determined by the type of stay used. Moreover, certain automobiles require the use of a carrier base and mounting hooks. Be sure to consult the FIT GUIDE, which is available at your dealer.





The mounting position, loadable cargo and maximum carrier capacity vary by vehicle type. Be sure to read "Mounting Methods by Vehicle Type" in the Installation Instructions for the Mounting Hooks.



When using the Carrier System, avoid driving at excessively high speeds. Do not make hard starts, unnecessarily sharp turns abrupt maneuvers or emergency braking. In case you have to perform a sharp turn, abrupt maneuver or emergency braking, always check afterwards to see that the carrier system and cargo remain secure.



Do not attempt to modify the carrier system.




Always check to see that the carrier and cargo are secured in place after driving continuously at high speeds, in adverse weather conditions, or when driving over rough roads.




Always use the key lock to secure the carrier.

Failure to do so may allow the carrier to come off, resulting in an accident.



Check the fastening knobs and bolts, width-adjustment screws and any other mounting hardware on a periodic basis to see that they are securely tightened.



Exercise caution when opening or closing the sunroof, hatch or

Failure to do so may cause the sunroof, hatch, gate or rear spoiler to hit the carrier and/or cargo.



Always remove the carrier system before running your car through a car wash.



 Do not concentrate the cargo in one area. Doing so may damage the carrier and/or cargo.



Mount the carrier system to your vehicle in a well-lit, open space on flat, stable ground.
