All mounting screws must be tightened evenly with the hex wrench on both sides until the spring washer flattens.







Etimes- Guidelines for Using the Carrier System

If you give the Carrier System to a third person, provide this manual to ensure safe installation and usage. Wash any mud off the carrier system. Use a damp towel to wipe away dust and dirt. Do not use any thinner or solvents to clean any part of the carrier system - use only mild soap or detergent if necessary..

Store all components of the carrier system together in one place to prevent any component from being lost. Avoid storage in areas subject to direct sunlight, high temperature or excessive humidity.
