
CARMATE MULTI Cradle





Additional parts (sold separately) are required for the cases below.

If you drive under any of the following conditions, be sure to fix the front and rear ends of the loading items to the tow hook using the belt (IN-718) sold separately.

 The overall length of loading items are longer than six times the space between the front and rear carrier.
 Wind speed is faster than 32.8 ft/s (10 m/s).
 Driving faster than 50 mph (80 km/h).




2 Install the base carrier

This attachment can be installed on INNO crossbars, factory crossbars, square and round crossbars (*1).

 $^{\star 1}$: Some sizes of crossbar require the ISF711 and ISF716 long bolt (sold separately).

 $^{\ast}2$: Mounting the attachment to a round bar requires the ISF715 round bar adaptor (sold separately).

70cm (27 inch)

H: ~1.0 inch *(~2.5 mm) [Without option] 1.0 inch – 2.0 inch (25~50 mm) [with optional accessories]

*ISF711 and ISF 716 (1 set for 1 kayak) may be required,

T: Distance to Roof : Min 2.0 inch (50 mm)

depending on the shape of crossbars.

Warning

- Check the instruction manual of either the carrier or the vehicle to ensure that the carrier / crossbar to which the attachment is installed has enough strength.
- If for any reason the carrier does not have enough strength, do not install it. The space between the front and rear carriers must be greater than 27 inch (70 cm).


If you are able to adjust the front and rear spaces, adjust them as wide as possible to make it more stable.

3 Temporarily fix the cradles

Temporarily fix front and rear cradles (4 parts) according to the shape of loading items.


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
Fix cradles after attaching loading items.



4 Attaching the loading item

Adjust the position of the loading item to be center of the front and rear crossbars. The kayak can be loaded upside down so that it is well-balanced.






5 Fixing the cradle

Adjust the cradle so that the loading item sits stable and tightening knob so that the lower plate adjust parallel to the cradle.




Load and unload loading items in a flat and large space.



6 Attaching the buckle pad

Pass the belt through the slits of buckle pad, and the place the buckle on the buckle pad.





10 Taking down the loading item

Remove the fixing belt, then unload items.

If extra belts are used to tighten front and rear of the loading item, take them off before unloading.
