

Installation Instructions

Tools Required

- Socket wrench with extension
- 3/4", 15MM, 18MM, & 22MM sockets
- 3/4", 15MM, 18MM, & 22MM box end wrench
- Regular screw driver
- Floor jack and wood block



Vehicle Preparation

- 1. A) Remove license plate, and OEM license plate lights. If so equipped, unplug back-up sensors and seal OEM connector with tape; affix to frame.
- B) Remove OEM <u>bumper</u> fasteners and OEM bumper. Set aside (**Fig 1**).
- C) Remove OEM spare tire access cover from bumper. Set aside.




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Bumper Install

- 2. A) Bolt bumper to frame using supplied hardware: bolts, washers, and nuts. Repeat for other side. Align spare tire access cover with guide tube (**Fig 2**).
- B) Align bumper front to back and tighten frame mount fasteners.
- C) Align bumper height side-to-side, verify tailgate clears while lowered, and tighten bumper mounting fasteners using 3/4" socket and wrench.
- D) Plug in license plate light harness and secure to frame rails.
- E) Re-install license plate.






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Tag Light Wiring
