**K&N® Cabin Air Filters** replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

**When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.**

1. Open the hood.
2. Locate cabin filter access cover. Fig. 1
3. Remove cabin filter cover Fig. 2
4. Remove cover from cabin filter tray. Fig. 3
5. Remove the dirty filter from the tray. Fig. 4
6. Install K&N® cabin filter into tray Fig. 5 and 6
7. Reverse steps 1-3 to complete the cabin filter installation. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area and apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter.
