



# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

**K&N® Cabin Air Filters** replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

**When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.**

1. Open the glove box and locate the support on the left side. Figs. 1 & 2
2. Disconnect the support and squeeze the sides of the glove box in to gain access to the cabin filter. Figs 3 & 4
3. Un-clip the tab on the filter cover and remove it. Figs. 5 & 6
4. Remove existing cabin filter. Fig. 7
5. Install K&N® cabin air filter with K&N® logo facing out and notch up. Figs. 8 & 9
6. Reverse steps 1-3 to complete the installation. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area near the filter door and apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a re-usable cabin filter.
