K&N® Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10-year/Million Mile Limited Warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

1. Open glovebox and disconnect door stay. (Figs. 1, 2 & 3)
2. Push in stop tabs to release glovebox down to gain access to cabin filter housing. (Figs. 4 & 5)
3. Open cabin filter door and remove dirty cabin air filter. Remove any debris that might be present inside the housing. (Fig. 6)
4. Install K&N cabin filter. **NOTE: Cabin filter must be completely seated to close cabin filter door.** (Figs. 7 & 8)
5. Once filter is installed, reverse the steps to complete the cabin air filter installation.
6. Clean an area on the cabin filter door and apply the K&N Stop Decal to notify others that this is a washable, reusable cabin filter.

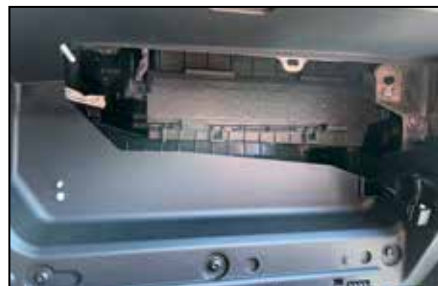
