K&N® Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N[®] cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/100,000 mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufactures installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N[®] cabin air filter.

- 1. Locate glove box.
- 2. Locate glove box hinge pins on glove box. Depending on your particular model, these could be located inside of the alove box, or on the outside underneath the alove box. Fig. 1 & 2
- 3. Remove glove box hinge pins. Fig. 3
- 4. With glove box open, apply pressure to the sides of the glove box pushing into the center. This will allow the glove box to open completely to gain access to the cabin filter housing. Fig. 4 NOTE: Some models are equipped with a stop cord. It is not necessary to remove, just allow the glove box to hang freely Fig. 5
- 5. Locate cabin filter housing behind glove box compartment and unfasten clips on the cabin filter cover. Fig. 6
- 6. Remove cabin filter from cabin filter housing. Fig. 7 NOTE: Remove any dirt or debris that may be present in the cabin filter housing.
- 7. Install K&N[®] Cabin Filter. Cabin filter will only fit in one direction, ensure that the pull tab is facing out when filter is installed. Fig. 8
- 8. Reinstall cabin filter cover onto cabin housing, ensure clips are locked in correctly.
- 9. Reverse steps 1-4 to complete cabin filter installation. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area on the housing and apply the K&N[®] Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter.


