INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS Part Number: VF3009

K&N® Cabin <u>Air Filters</u> replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/100,000 mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufactures installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

- 1. Locate access panel under the glove box. Fig. 1
- 2. Locate and remove screws to access cabin filter housing. Fig. 2 & 3
- 3. Remove cabin filter cover by sliding it to the right. Remove dirty cabin filter. Fig. 4, 5 & 6
- 4. Once dirty cabin filter is removed clean any debris that might be present on the cabin filter housing.
- 5. Install K&N® Cabin Filter in air box with the angled side of filter on the right hand side.

 NOTE: The cut out on the right side of the filter will help with installation. Fig. 7, 8 & 9
- 6. Reinstall cabin filter air box cover. With the Cabin Filter installed, apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter.
- 7. Reverse steps 2 and 3 to complete cabin filter installation.


