K&N® Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock [cabin filter](#) with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/100,000 mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufactures installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

1. Open glove box compartment. (Fig. 1)
2. Remove plastic clip from the right side of the glove box. (Fig. 2)
3. Push in the sides of the compartment one at a time to release the tabs on each side. (Fig. 3)
4. Let glove box drop and remove from hinges. (Fig. 4)
5. Remove plastic panel located above the cabin filter door. (Fig. 5 & 6) **NOTE: Some models may not have this panel.**
6. Open cabin filter door by pulling the latch on the left and pressing the lock tab located at top of the door. (Fig. 7 & 8)
7. Remove dirty cabin filter and remove any debris that might be present inside the cabin filter housing. (Fig. 9)
8. Install K&N® cabin filter. (Fig. 10) **NOTE: Cabin Filter can only be installed in one direction with the tab facing out.**
9. Place door back on cabin filter housing and reverse steps 1-5 to complete cabin filter installation. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area on the housing and apply K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter.

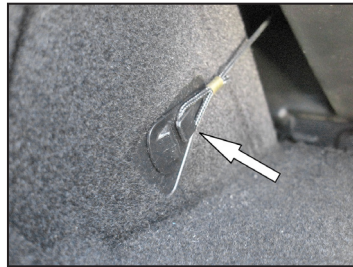

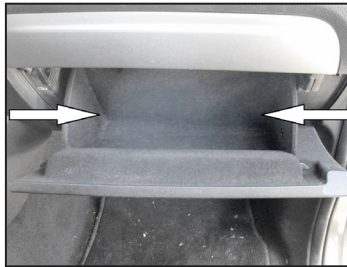

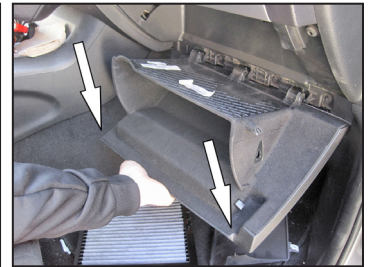

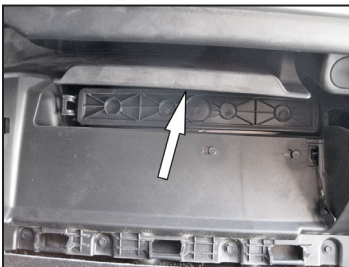

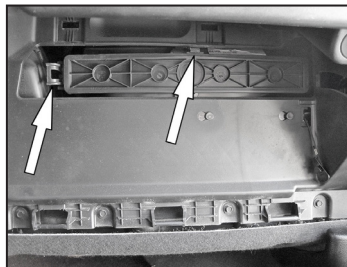
