

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS Part Number: VF3016

K&N® Cabin <u>Air Filters</u> replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/100,000 mile limited warranty.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufactures installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

- 1. Open the hood and locate the cowl panel.
- 2. Remove the cowl to gain access to the cabin filter housing. Fig. 1 & 2
- 3. Unclip the cabin air filter housing cover to access the cabin air filters. NOTE: Cover will flip down. Fig. 3
- 4. Remove dirty cabin air filters from the housing by sliding them out. Clean any debris that might be present in the cabin filter housing.
- 5. Install K&N® Cabin Air Filters. NOTE: Slide the small K&N® Cabin Air Filter in and to the right side of housing, then install the larger K&N® Cabin Air Filter. Fig. 4 & 5
- 6. Reverse steps 1-3 to complete cabin filter installation. With the cabin filters installed, apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a re-usable cabin air filter.
