



# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

**K&N® Cabin Air Filters** replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs. When they get dirty they can be cleaned and reused and best of all, they come with a 10 year/Million mile limited warranty.

**When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.**

1. Open hood and locate the cabin filter housings on the driver and passenger side of the engine compartment near the fire wall. (Fig. 1)
2. Unplug the pig tails from the sensors that are on the passenger side housing. (Fig. 2 & Fig. 3)
3. Remove the bolts and unclip the lids on both housings to access cabin filters. (Fig.4-7)
4. Remove cabin filters from both housings. (Fig. 8)  
**NOTE: Remove any debris that might be present inside the cabin filter housing.**
5. Install K&N® cabin filters into the lids with arrows pointing up and filter features facing out. (Fig. 9)  
**NOTE: Cabin filter can only be installed one way.**
6. Reverse steps 1-3 to complete cabin filter installation. With the cabin filter installed, clean an area on the housing and apply K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that this is a reusable cabin filter.
