


Fitting Tools required:

- Flat blade Screwdriver.
- Torx key set.
- Large pair of pliers.
- Utility knife.

Installation Instructions

- 1. Carefully unclip and remove the intake hose from the air box. (Fig. #1)
- 2. Carefully pull the vacuum hose from the airbox vent as shown. (Fig. #2)
- 3. Unscrew and remove the air filter housing lid from the vehicle. (Fig. #3)
- 4. Remove all screws from the original air filter housing lid. (Fig. #4)
- 5. Remove the paper air filter from the air filter housing and remove the plate in the air filter housing base by carefully pulling it upwards. (Fig. #5)
- 6. Fit the screws into the new K&N air filter housing lid as shown. (Fig. #6)
- 7. Fit the K&N panel air filter into the air filter housing base, a light bead of sealing grease must be applied to the sealing edge of the air filter as marked with the yellow line on the image. (Fig. #7)
- 8. Fit the K&N air filter housing lid onto the original air filter housing base and secure the original screws, secure the intake hose onto the K&N air filter housing lid using the original hose clamp. (Fig. #8)
- 9. Fit the vacuum hose onto the air filter housing. (Fig. #9)
- 10. Carry out a final height alignment check of the kit fitment, installation is now complete. (Fig. #10)

It is possible to open up the grill intake, this will result in a higher air flow. This configuration is not allowed in countries which have TUV regulations.

- 11. Unscrew and remove the intake snorkel lid, unclip the coolant hose, and remove the air box feed adaptor as shown. (Fig. #11 & 12)
- 12. Remove the 2 screws which secure the intake snorkel to the slam panel and remove the intake snorkel from the vehicle. (Fig. #13)
- 13. Cut out the marked section to provide a higher air flow towards the air filter housing. (Fig. #14)
- 14. Refit the intake snorkel, the airbox feed adaptor, coolant hose and the intake snorkel lid.
