



# INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

K&N Cabin Air Filters replace your vehicle's stock cabin filter with a reusable design that cleans and freshens incoming air. They are electrostatically charged to grab and hold dust particles. K&N® cabin air filters help control odors while they help capture most mold, mildew, fungus, spores, bacteria and germs.

When applicable, refer to owner's manual for manufacturers installation/removal instructions. The following are helpful steps when replacing/servicing cabin air filter with K&N® cabin air filter.

1. Open the hood and locate the cowl cover on the passenger side. Fig. 1
2. Twist the 4 plastic nuts ¼ turn counterclockwise and remove the cowl cover. Fig 2
3. Remove the electrical connector. Fig 3
4. Twist the 3 plastic nuts ¼ turn and remove the filter lid. Fig 4
5. Turn the filter lid over to locate the two filters. Press the tabs in to remove the dirty filters. Figs 5 & 6
6. Install the K&N® filters so that the 4 tabs on each filter lock into the slots on the lid. Figs 7, 8, & 9
7. Reverse steps 1-4 to complete the installation. With the cabin filters installed, clean an area on the filter lid and apply the K&N® Stop Decal. The decal will help notify others that these are re-usable cabin filters.

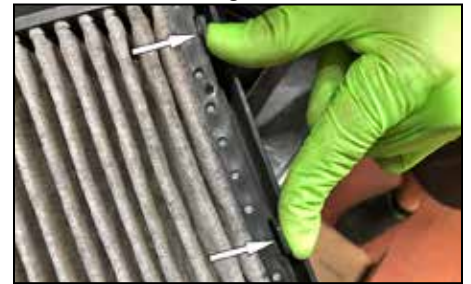
