# WARNINGS



### Surfaces will be hot

Allow all parts to cool before handling.



#### Fire hazard

When the exhaust system is disconnected, always keep exhaust stream away from wiring and other flammables. Keep a fire extinguisher handy.



## Wear safety goggles



Use proper ventilation

Avoid breathing in exhaust



## TESTING AT THE OXYGEN SENSOR

- 1. Refer to vehicle service manual for correct back pressure specifications and troubleshooting procedures.
- 2. Disconnect the oxygen sensor wires and remove the oxygen sensor.
- 3. Install the oxygen sensor adapter and connect the gauge assembly.
- 4. Repeat step 1.

## TESTING AT THE EXHAUST PIPES

- 1. Refer to vehicle service manual for correct back pressure specifications and troubleshooting procedures.
- 2. Put the vehicle on the lift and drill a 3/8" (9.5mm) hole in front of the catalytic converter, avoiding welded seams.
- 3. Slip the tool nut on the tool bolt with the knurling on the nut away from the hex.
- 4. Screw on the insert nut with the knurling facing the knurling on the tool nut. Push the assembly into the 3/8" hole.
- 5. Hold the tool nut with a 9/16" wrench and turn the hex bolt clockwise with a 7/16" wrench until the insert nut is tight in the pipe and the hex bolt will no longer turn.
- 6. Loosen hex bolt counter-clockwise to remove.
- 7. Screw in brass test adapter and connect gauge assembly.
- 8. Repeat step 1.
