X-431 Torque

The handset acts as the central processing system, which is used to receive and analyze the live vehicle data from the VCI connector and then output the test result.

Quick Start Guide



VCI (Vehicle Communication Interface)

The VCI connector works as a vehicle communication interface device, which is used to connect to the vehicle's DLC (Data Link Connector) socket directly or via OBD II extension cable to read the vehicle data and then send it to the handset via Bluetooth. It only works with the vehicle with 12V battery voltage.



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Notes:

• If the battery remains unused for a long period of time or the battery is completely discharged, it is normal that the tool will not power on while being charged. Please charge it for a period of 5 minutes and then turn it on.

For details on how to charge, refer to Section 1 "Charging & Turning On".

Please use the included power adaptor to charge your tool. No responsibility can be assumed for any damage or loss caused as a result of using power adaptors other than the one supplied.

Power indicator

(It lights up while the VCI connector is plugged into the vehicle's DLC.)

Bluetooth communication indicator

(By default, it is in Bluetooth mode when the connector is powered up and illuminates blue.)

Install the VCI connector

1. Locate vehicle's DLC socket: The DLC(Data Link Connector) is typically a 16-pin connector where diagnostic code readers interface with the vehicle's on-board computer. It is usually located on driver's side, about 12 inches away from the center of dashboard. See Figure **DLC Location**. In case no DLC is found, please refer to Automobile Repair Manual.

ECU communication indicator

(It flashes when the VCI connector is communicating with the vehicle.)

Mini USB port (Reserved for subsequent function extension.)

- DLC Location
- Plug the VCI connector into the vehicle's DLC(It is suggested to use the OBD II extension cable to connect the DLC and the VCI). Normally the power indicator of the VCI will light up.

I. Charging & Turning On

- 1. Plug one end of the included power adaptor into the USB port of the handset, and then other end into the AC outlet.
- 2. Once the battery is fully charged, disconnect the power adaptor from the AC outlet.
- 3. Press the [POWER] button on the handset, the system starts initializing and then enters the home screen.

2. Changing Language

X-431 Torque supports multiple languages. To change the language of the tool, please do the following:

- 1. On the home screen, tap on Settings -> Language & Input -> Languages.
- 2. Tap on "Add a language", and then choose the desired language from the list.
- 3. Tap and hold the desired language and drag it to the top of the screen and then release it, the system will change into the target language.

3. Wi-Fi Setup

X-431 Torque has a built-in Wi-Fi module that can be used to get online. Once you're online, you can register your tool, update the diagnostic software & APK, surf the Internet, get apps and send email on your network.

1. On the home screen, select Settings -> Wi-Fi.

- 2. Select the Wi-Fi switch to ON, X-431 Torque will start searching for available wireless networks.
- 3. Select a wireless network:
 - If the chosen network is open X-431 Torque will connect automatically.
 - If the selected network is encrypted a network password will need to be entered.

5. Vehicle Connection

The method used to connect the diagnostic connector to a vehicle's DLC depends on the vehicle's configuration as follows:

- A vehicle equipped with an OBD II management system supplies both communication and 12V power through a standardized DLC.
- A vehicle not equipped with an OBD II management system supplies communication through a DLC connection, and in some cases supplies 12V power through the cigarette lighter receptacle or a connection to the vehicle battery.

1. OBD II Vehicle Connection

A Directly plug the VCI into vehicle's DLC

B Using OBD II extension cable

6. Start Diagnostics

X-431 Torque support two kinds of diagnosis approaches: Smart Diagnosis and Manual Diagnosis.

Smart Diagnosis(AutoDetect):

Through simple Bluetooth communication between the X-431 Torque handset and VCI connector, you can easily get the VIN (Vehicle Identification Number) information of the currently identified vehicle. Once the VIN is successfully identified, the system will retrieve it from the remote server and then guide you to vehicle information page without the necessity of step-by-step manual menu selection.

Manual Diagnosis:

In this mode, you have to diagnose a vehicle by performing the menu-driven command manually.

For new users, please follow the operation chart shown on the left to get familiar with and start using this tool.

Before diagnosing, please make sure the following:

- · Switch the ignition on.
- · Vehicle battery voltage range should be 9-14Volts.
- Throttle should be in a closed position.

- 2. If you choose "AutoDetect" to diagnose a vehicle, this flowchart shall not apply.
