**Lucas Fuel Treatment cleans and lubricates valves, pumps, carburetors, injectors and compression rings. It is an absolute must for rotary pumps! Lucas Fuel Treatment safely replaces the need for lead in older engines.**

**Lucas Fuel Treatment is an excellent diesel tune up! Before going to the shop with an engine that is smoking or low on power, we suggest that you try adding about a half gallon of our treatment to each 100 gallons of fuel. This is often all it needs!**

32 oz (1 quart)/946 mL treats 100 gallons gasoline or diesel.  
128 oz (1 gallon)/3785 mL treats 400 gallons gasoline or diesel.**
