

READ INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE INSTALLING PRODUCT

SHOP SUPPLIES:



SPRAY LUBRICANT

To ease removal of existing exhaust components (especially on older vehicles) spray penetrating lubricant on all fasteners and hangers/insulators that will be loosened or removed and let soak before disassembly.


WARNING: When working on, under, or around any vehicle exercise caution. Please allow the vehicle's exhaust system to cool before removal, as exhaust system temperatures may cause severe burns. If working without a lift always consult vehicle manual for correct lifting specifications. Always wear safety glasses and ensure a safe work area. Serious injury or death could occur if safety measures are not followed.

ATTENTION: Always install any supplied band or U-bolt clamps to the proper torque specifications of 40-45 ft-lb for band clamps and 30-35 ft-lb for U-bolt clamps. Over tightening will result in the clamps breaking and will NOT be warranted by MagnaFlow.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS







Step 1 and Step 3 are for vehicles equipped with Active Exhaust, skip these steps if your vehicle is not equipped with Active Exhaust

Step 4 is for applications with aftermarket headers. Please note that depending on the manufacturer of the headers, header connection pipe may require modification to fit as each exhaust manufacturer may have unique profiles.





Step 1. To remove the OEM system first unplug the electrical connector at the exhaust valves.

Step 2. Begin by loosening the clamps at the exhaust inlet. Remove all four welded hangers from the rubber insulators and remove the exhaust. Do not damage the fasteners or rubber insulators as they will be used to install the new MagnaFlow system.

Step 3. Once the exhaust is off of the vehicle remove the valve motors from the muffler assembly and transfer it over to the new MagnaFlow exhaust valve assembly using the factory hardware.

Step 4. (OPTIONAL) If installing on a vehicle with aftermarket headers, modifying the Extreme Delete Tru-x and Tru-x Muffler module will be required to accommodate header pipe connection. First cut the reduced section of pipe off of the inlet pipes on the Extreme Delete Tru-x and Tru-x Muffler module. Then attach the header adapter pipes with the supplied 2.50" torca clamps. The modules will now have a 3.00" interior diameter to accommodate 3.00" aftermarket headers. Depending on the various header applications modifications may be required.





Step 5. MagnaFlow xMOD exhausts are designed with multiple build options giving the ability to use different components depending on sound and performance preference (See Page 5 and 6).

Begin installation of the MagnaFlow system by attaching either the TRU-X xTreme Delete or the TRU-X Muffler Module to the OE Converter outlet pipes using the OE clamps. Next, attach the Extension Assemblies using two of the supplied V clamps and engaging the hangers into the rubber insulators. (Leave all clamps and fasteners loose for final adjustment of the complete system.)






Step 6. The NDT Muffler assemblies are shipped with the xTreme Bypass modules installed without the xTreme Bypass Block-Off Plates. Depending on preference, there are four different exhaust configurations possible with this system in either non-Active Exhaust (See Page 5) or Active Exhaust configurations (See Page 6).

Determine the best configuration for your preference. If using xTreme Bypass / Block-Off open no modifications are needed. If using MagnaFlow Valves remove the xTreme Bypass from the NDT Muffler Assemblies by loosening the V clamps and loosely installing Valve Assemblies. If using the xTreme Bypass / Block-Off closed loosen the front V clamp of xTreme Bypass and insert Block-Off Plate to counter bore of flange then loosely tighten. For every configuration make sure the flanges are aligned straight and do final tightening of V clamps when mufflers are installed on vehicle for proper tip alignment.

Step 8. Once a final position has been chosen for the new exhaust system, evenly tighten all clamps and fasteners, from front to rear, using the torque specifications on page one of the instructions. Inspect all fasteners after 25-50 miles of operation and re-tighten if necessary.
