





Important Notes: Make sure your vehicle roof is clean from any dust and dirt before installing. This product May Not be Suitable for use on vehicles that are fitted with side curtain or overhead airbags. The straps can prohibit the airbags from deploying properly. Moisture can potentially wick down nylon strapping when wet and into vehicle. Crossbars must be at least 24" apart for safe transport. Do not tamper with load strap and/or buckle while in transit.

Assembly & Use Instructions - Please Read Before Beginning FOR USE WITH BARE ROOFED VEHICLES



Insert the tower attachment bracket into the top of the tower as pictured in figure 1.

• Capture the nylon lock nut in the hex shaped hole of the tower. See Figure 2





 Insert Allen bolt into the remaining round hole and secure with provided wrench. Do not over tighten. See Figures 3 & 3A • Add the end caps to cross bars. Push firmly to secure. See Figure 4. Repeat steps 1 thru 4 to complete remaining 3 towers.





• With assembly complete, loosen the towers set screw on the underside of the tower attachment bracket. This will allow the tower to slide along the cross bar so we can fit it to the vehicle's width. NOTE: We will tighten this screw after fitting the vehicle. See Figures 5 & 5A

You should now have two(2) completely assembled cross bars ready to install. Review the previous steps if yours does not look like the photo below.



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Mounting The Cross Bars

IMPORTANT: Careful attention should be made to the placement of the towers on the vehicles roof. The preferred placement is right along the edge of the roof, at it's strongest point. The

vacuum cups will act as cushions or pads even if placed over roof ridge lines preventing a full seal. Do Not place towers inwards or on a glass sunroof.

NOTE TOWER POSITION: PLACE TOWERS OVER/ON ROOF- RIDGE LINES FOR PROPER PLACEMENT








• Open the vehicle's doors and place cross bars in desired location With the towers placed as to close to the edge as possible.

Measuring at least 24" between them. See Figure 1


• With the towers placed as to close to the edge as possible, secure the towers by firmly pressing them downwards securing them to the roof. See Figures 2 & 2A





• Go back and fully tightening the towers set set loosened in step 5 of the assembly. See Figure 3

• Dress the load strap through the vehicle, and into the large cam buckle. Pulling firmly to tighten. See Figure 4



• Neatly fold up any leftover strapping and secure with hook and loop enclosure. See Figure 5



Your VersaRail system is now complete! Be sure to double check all hardware and straps prior to transport.





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
