







■ Mounting Location

Center the cab organizer between the front seats and at proper distance from partition (refer to chart), and mark (4) mounting hole locations:










Partition	A=Distance from partition
Steel partition w/ standard setback panels	2.5"
Steel partition w/ 3" setback panels	3"
Steel partition w/ 6" setback panels	4"
Quiet flex partition	2"



■ Installation Methods


Note: Using a 1-1/8" hole saw specifically made for mat cutting, hole saw out all holes in the mat making sure to align hole saw with pre-drilled holes. Make sure not to drill through the meal floor of the van. Once drilled, clear out each area of excess debris.








■ Through Floor








USE DRILL STOP TO PREVENT DAMAGING VEHICLE








C-500 tool tightens bolt thru hex head cap into Plusnut® A ratchet, open-end or closed –end wrench can be used.







■ Cab Organizer Features

Your cab organizer will enable you to:

- **A.** Lock valuables in a theft resistant box.
- **B.** Lift the double-action lid for easy access.
- C. Slide the double-action forward for a convenient writing surface. A safety latch/ release button is provided.
- D. Organize papers by using standard "Pendaflex" style hanging folders on the bottom tracks.
- E. Have safe and easy access to equipment or small items using the upper sliding tray.
- F. Safeguard against premature lid falling with a counter-balance spring.
