Removal of Stock System

- 1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators. **Refer to Figure 1& 2**.
- 2. Remove the clamp just after the catalytic convertor.
- 3. Remove the stock exhaust from the existing rubber isolators and remove the system from the vehicle. **Refer to Figure 1& 2**.

Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust

- 1. <u>Install the Extension Pipe</u> onto the catalytic converter using the **3 1/2" Clamp**. Insert the hanger into the existing rubber insulator. Leave all clamps loose enough for adjustment. **Refer to Figure 3**.
- 2. Install the **Muffler** over the **Extension Pipe**. A 4" Clamp is used at the connection between the **Muffler** and the **Extension Pipe**. Install the **Hanger Clamp** into the two existing rubber insulators located above the **Muffler**.

- 3. Install the **Tail Pipe** from the rear of the truck, over the axle and attach to the **Muffler** outlet. Install the tail pipe hanger into the existing rubber insulator.
- 4. Install and adjust the **Exhaust Tip** to suit.
- 6. Align the exhaust as required. Starting at the front of the exhaust, tighten all clamps and connections.
- 7. Check along the whole length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance around the spare tire, fuel and brake lines or any wiring. If any interference is detected relocate or adjust.
