



1 Place the label with the door lock replacement key code onto the inside of your vehicle's glove compartment, or by completing the remaining portion of the form and returning it to McGard in the envelope provided. This service is FREE. Registration will assist you if you ever need to order a replacement key.



2 On the upper door hinge, hang/place paint protector centered just below the hinge nut. For some YJ models use painters tape to hold in place.



3 Using the appropriate driver, socket, or bit, remove the hinge nut.



4 Insert key tool into hinge lock and engage lock nut pattern.



5 Thread the lock into hinge by hand.



6 Using a 1/4" ratchet and key tool, tighten the lock to approximately 80-90in.lbs. Do not over-tighten. Remove key tool and paint protector. Repeat process on other doors (one lock per door).



7 Place your key tool, extra hinge nuts and this instruction sheet into the package and close. Store this package in a secure location inside the vehicle. It's also a good idea to have a spare key, or on the order form contained in the package and return it to McGard along with your Door Lock Registration Form. A nylon and elastic key storage pouch can also be ordered.
