




# FORD FREESTAR 2004-2007 MERCURY MONTEREY 2004-2007

- **1** Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- 2 Unsnap and remove entire panel surrounding radio and climate controls. (FIGURE A)
- **3** Remove (4) 7mm screws to remove factory radio. **(FIGURE B)**





# FORD FOCUS 2005-2007

- 1 Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent accidental short circuit.
- 2 Unsnap and remove entire panel surrounding the radio and climate controls.

**3** Remove (4) 7mm screws to remove factory radio.








# **F SERIES SUPER DUTY 2005-2007**

- 1 Disconnect the negative battery terminal to prevent an accidental short circuit.
- Unsnap and remove entire panel surrounding radio and climate controls.(FIGURE A)
- **3** Remove (4) 7mm screws to remove factory radio.






#### **DIN HEAD UNIT PROVISIONS:**

- 1 Slide the DIN cage into the Radio Housing and secure by bending the metal locking tabs down. (Figure A)
- 2 Slide the after-market head unit into the cage and secure. (Figure B)



# KIT ASSEMBLY


# **ISO DIN Head Unit Provision**



- **1** Mount the ISO Brackets to the head unit with the screws supplied with the unit.
- 2 Slide the head unit into the radio opening until the side clips engage.
- **3** Snap the Trim plate into the Radio Housing.



# FINAL ASSEMBLY



- Strip wire ends back 1/2"
- B) Twist ends together
- C) Solder
- D) Tape
- 1 Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Metra recommends using the proper mating adapter and making the connections as shown. (Isolate and individually tape off the ends of any unused wires to prevent electrical short circuit)
- 2 Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- 3 Reassemble radio and dash assemblies in reverse order of disassembly.
