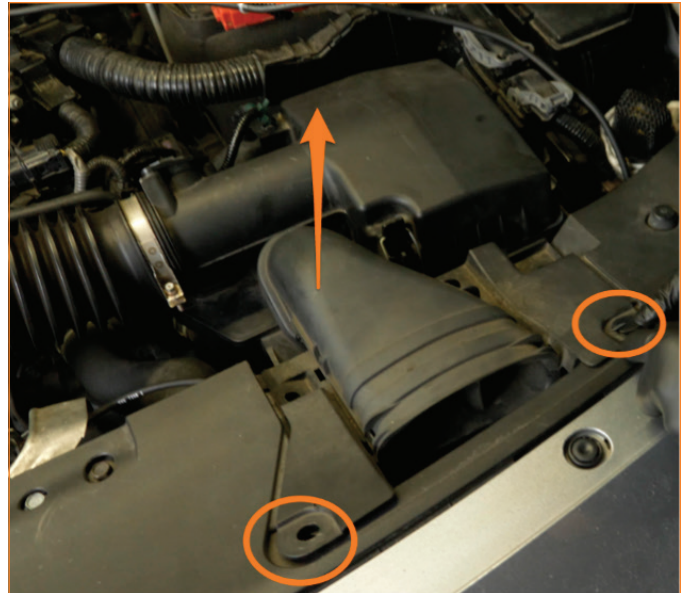
INSTALLATION DIFFICULTY

TOOLS NEEDED

POP CLIP TOOL OR SMALL FLAT HEAD SCREWDRIVER	1/4" RATCHET AND EXTENSIONS
5.5MM, 7MM, 8MM, 10MM SOCKETS	2.5MM ALLEN KEY PHILIP HEAD SCREWDRIVER

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the 2x pop clips, then take the air duct off from the stock airbox by lifting it straight up.

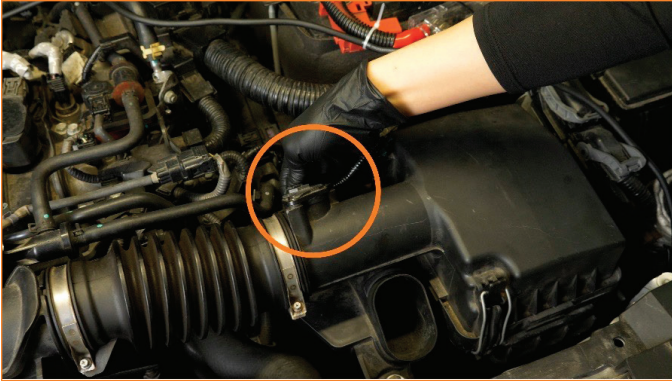


2. Unclip the MAF sensor harness from the airbox.

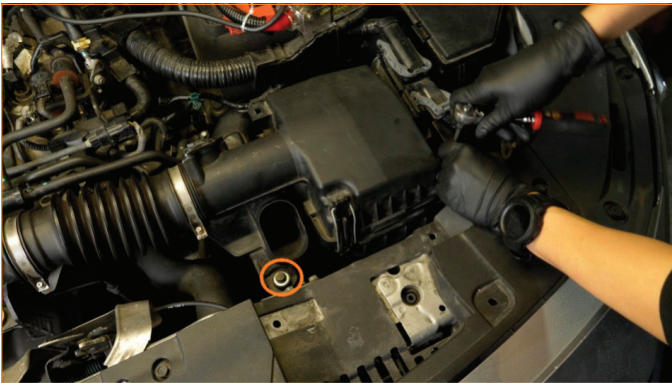

3. Disconnect MAF sensor.



4. Remove 2x 10mm bolts securing the stock airbox.



5. Remove airbox from the engine bay. Make sure the bottom rubber grommet comes out with the airbox.



6. Transfer the MAF sensor from the stock airbox to Mishimoto MAF housing, install with provided hardware. (2x 2.5mm button head bolts)



7. Transfer the 3x mounting grommets from the stock airbox to the Mishimoto airbox.



8. Assemble the rubber grommet, MAF housing, and air filter as shown.



9. Install the MAF housing assembly by inserting the air filter end into the airbox, then push on the rubber grommet until the lip is fully engaged.



10. Install the airbox assembly, push down to engage the bottom grommet with the metal peg in the engine bay.



11. Install the silicone hose and 2x worm gear clamps, then tighten down the airbox with the provided hardware. (2x 10mm bolts and washers)



12. Clip the MAF harness to the Mishimoto airbox, then reconnect the sensor.
