

APPLICATION:

2010 and up Camaro SS and COPO Camaro without a tank

Installation

- 1. Locate the post protruding through the top of the frame rail next to the radiator.
- 2. Fit the tank so the center of the slot on the top front mounting tab aligns with the center of the post on the frame rail.
- 3. Mark the midpoint of each mounting tab slot on the frame rail. Then remove the tank.
- 4. Using a 17/32 drill bit, drill holes in the frame rail at the marked locations.
- ***NOTE**: Be careful to drill a clean, round hole so the rivet nuts fit properly. (Some model years may require the post to be drilled out as well to accept the 3/8 rivet nut). Use a 17/32 drill bit if this is the case.
- 5. Install the 3/8 rivet nut on the post and the (3) remaining 5/16 rivet nuts in the other holes using a Rivet Nut Tool. (see images above for nut locations)
- 6. Reinstall the tank on the rivet nuts and fasten it using the provided washers and hex head cap screws.
- *NOTE: the 4 hole bracket at the bottom of the tank will accept a GM supplied intercooler pump.
- 7. Using a 16 AN hose end, connect the return line on the rear facing upper fitting.
- 8. Connect the supply line, for the pump, to the rear facing lower tube fitting using a 1 inch hose.

APPLICATION:

2010 and up COPO Camaro with a plastic tank

Installation

- 1. Remove the preexisting plastic tank
- 2. Test fit the Moroso tank to verify that the holes in the frame rail line up with the slots on the tank. (Direct Fitment may vary based on model year)
- 3. If some or all of the holes **DO NOT** align properly, please refer to **Step #3** of the instructions above.
- 4. If the holes **DO** align properly please refer to **Step #2** of the instructions below

APPLICATION:

2010 and up COPO Camaro with an aluminum tank

Installation

- 1. Remove the preexisting aluminum tank
- 2. Install the Moroso tank on the rivet nuts, in the same location, and fasten it using the provided washers and hex head cap screws.
- 3. Reconnect the return and supply lines that were removed from the preexisting tank on the Moroso tank.
