

## Alternator Single Groove Aluminum Pulley #5320

## Fits most Delco and Ford Alternators INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow this procedure to install this aluminum pulley:

- 1. Remove negative (-) cable from battery and disconnect wires from alternator. *Be sure to note wire positions.*
- 2. Remove alternator from vehicle and place on bench or suitable work area.
- 3. Holding the center shaft with a hex wrench, loosen and remove the pulley nut, washer and stock pulley.
- 4. Remove the three #4 socket head screws from #5320 aluminum pulley and separate pulley and nose.
- 5. Install aluminum pulley on alternator shaft with raised spacer boss toward alternator.
- 6. Replace stock washer and nut, then securely tighten nut to 50 ft. lbs.
- Install pulley nose and securely tighten the three #4 socket head screws, using Loctite sealant on the threads.
  CAUTION: Do not overtighten or you may strip the threads.
- Reinstall alternator on car, connect wires to proper terminals, adjust belt to proper G.M. or Ford specified tension.
- 9. Be sure that all connections and mounting bolts have been tightened correctly.
- 10. Reconnect negative (-) battery cable.
