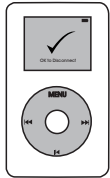

Changing Sources (iPod, HD Radio, *Satellite Radio, AUX)

- Press the "Radio" button until "Sat" is displayed.
- Press the "Seek \curvearrowright " button until the source you want is displayed.
- Press the "Tune \sphericalangle " button to select the source.

Scan

- Press to exit browse menu
- Press while listening to iPod to toggle through random modes.

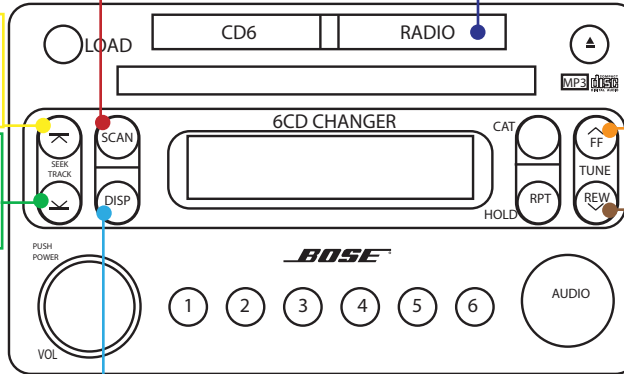
Radio Button - Press to enter into Sat mode or to switch modes within the Media Gateway

Seek \curvearrowright

- Press to advance to the next track
- Press to advance to the next option in the browse menu

Seek \curvearrowleft

- Press to go back to the previous track
- Press to go back to the previous option in the browse menu



Tune \wedge Press to go back one step while in the browse menu

Tune \sphericalangle
• Press to enter into the browse menu
• Press to make a selection while in the browse menu

Display Button - Press to toggle through display modes.

Browsing Example:

To select the song "Star-Spangled Banner" through the Artist category

1) Press the Tune \sphericalangle button to enter into the Browse menu. The radio will display "PL:List"

2) Press the Seek \curvearrowright button until radio displays "AR:Artist". Prss the Tune \sphericalangle button to select. Radio will display "AR:All"

3) Press the Seek \curvearrowright button until radio displays "AR:Francis Scott Key". Press the Tune \sphericalangle button to select. Radio will display "AL:All".

4) Press the Seek \curvearrowright button until radio displays "AL:Patriot Hits Vol.1". Press the Tune \sphericalangle button to select. Radio will display "TR:All".

5) Press the Seek \curvearrowright button until radio displays "TR:Star-Spangled Banner". Press the Tune \sphericalangle button to select. Song will begin to play and the display will show track info.

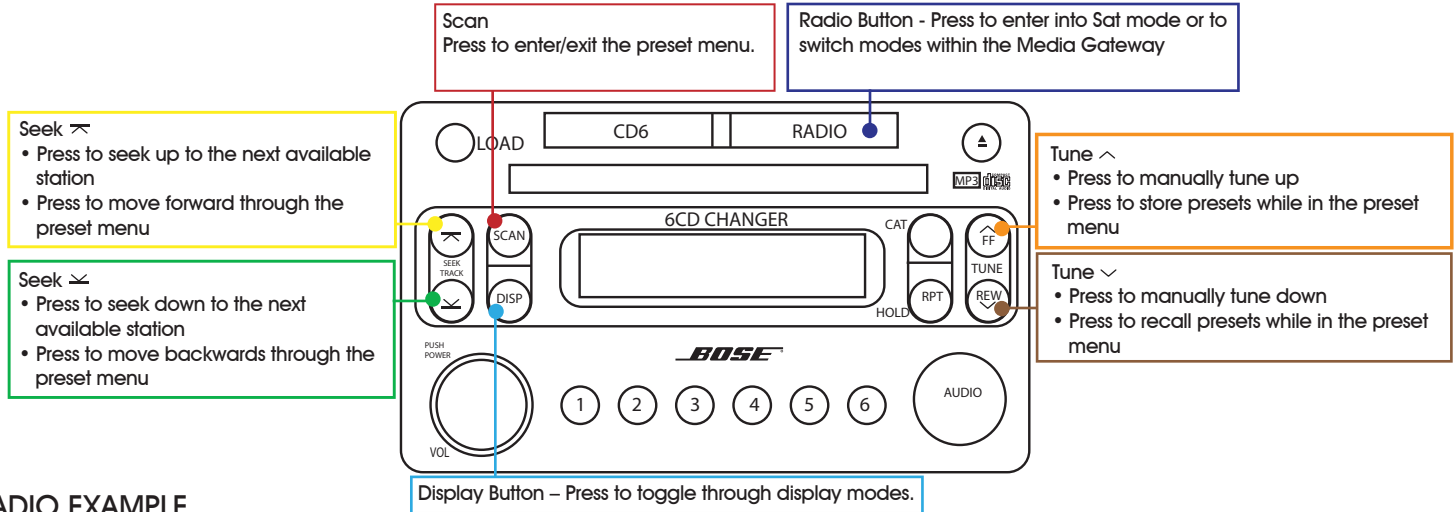

HD RADIO EXAMPLE

To select an HD radio station.

Press the 'SEEK ∇ ' button to get to the desired station. The Radio will auto lock on to an HD Radio Station if available example: 92.5 HD1MHZ. When locked into an HD Radio Station, press the 'SEEK ∇ ' button up to access multi-cast HD Station(s). (if available) example: 92.5 HD2 MHZ

To store a radio station into preset memory.

Press the "Scan" button to enter the Preset Menu. Press the "Seek ∇ " button until the location you want is displayed. Press the "Tune \wedge " button to store the preset. Radio will display "PR Saved"

To recall a station stored into preset memory.

Press the "Scan" button to enter the Preset Menu. Press the "Seek ∇ " button until the preset you want to recall is displayed. Press the "Tune \vee " button to recall the preset.

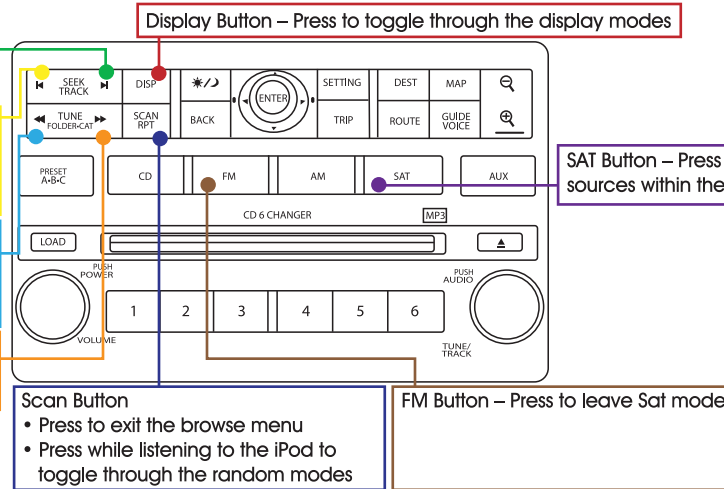

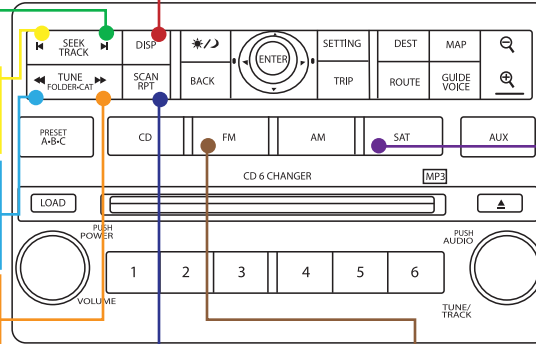

SAT Button – Press to enter SAT mode or change sources within the Media Gateway

Scan Button – Press to enter or exit the preset menu

FM Button – Press to leave Sat mode
