

- It is critical that all bolts and nuts are tightened, improper tightening can cause serious injury or death.
- A 4 wheel alignment is not needed after installation of this part.


Parts Included with the PERRIN Front Control Arm Front Bushing:

- (4) Urethane Bushings for Control Arm
- (2) Steel Sleeves
- (1) Urethane Grease Packet



Removal and Installation:

- 1) Park car on a smooth level surface. Using suitable commercial vehicle hoist or floor jack, raise vehicle onto jack stands. NEVER WORK UNDER A VEHICLE SOLELY SUPPORTED BY A JACK! DEATH OR INJURY MAY OCCUR.
- 2) Using factory service manual for reference, remove both front transverse links from vehicle. The basic steps are: Remove nuts and bolts securing control arm brace, remove bolts securing outer ball joint to hub, remove bolt and nut securing front control arm bushing to sub frame.
- 3) Using proper dies or press tools, remove OEM bushing from control arm.



Make Sure and Grease Here

- 4) Apply supplied grease to outsides of both bushings and press them into the control arm as shown above.
- 5) Apply supplied grease to outsides of supplied steel sleeves as well as to inside of bushings. **Note: Error on using too much** grease rather than too little. Excessive grease will just push out and can be wiped off after installation.
- 6) Press sleeves into bushings. Make sure and push them back and forth a few times to move the grease around.
- 7) Reinstall control arms back into car following factory service manual. See above diagram for proper torque specs for all bolts removed.
- 8) Lower vehicle from hoist or jack stands.
- 9) Road test vehicle and listen for any clunks or abnormal sounds. If any abnormal sounds are found, recheck installation.
- 10) If you live in an area that is highly corrosive or roads are salted in the winter time, re-greasing of bushings every other year may be required, or whenever they start to become squeaky.
