- 1. Remove the stock coupler tube from the trailers receiver tube.
- **2.** Fit the Cushion Coupler into the trailers receiver tube with the coupler release handle facing straight forward.
- **3.** Secure your Cushion Coupler with the original set bolts and/or locking pin provided by the trailer manufacturer.

**Note:** The CC2 is provided with a Lock Collar, which is used in place of a Thru Pin. The Collar is not used on the offset models.

**4.**Attach the cable to the coupler release lever with a cable clamp. Install eye bolts in the trailer neck to allow the cable to be run to a convenient location near the jack handle. When taking weight off the truck, simply pull the cable to release the coupler from the ball.

Lubricate the inside of the coupler with a thin film of lithium grease.

The three bolts thru the cushion are pre-set at the factory. No further adjustment is necessary
