


Installation:

Installation of the PPE Transfer Case Brace can be accomplished with the transmission in or out of the vehicle.

Transfer Case Brace shown installed in diagram for reference.

Step 1: Remove the factory bolts (shown in the diagram below) from the top of the transfer case and rear housing.



- **Step 2:** Place Transfer Case Brace in position and install factory bolts.
- Step 3: Tighten the 2 transfer case bolts to 36 ft. lbs. Do not over torque.
- **Step 4:** Tighten Allison rear housing bolts (M10 x 1.5 x 40) bolts to 38 ft. lbs. **Do not over torque.**

Installation is complete.
