Chrysler Bushing Installer & Reamer Tool

The PROFORM® Chrysler bushing installer and reamer tool is designed to easily and precisely install and ream a distributor bushing during the installation process.



Instructions:

- 1. Completely disassemble the tool before use.
- 2. Slide a new bushing, flange first, over the reamer tip end of the tool. The bushing should fit tightly on the end of the tool.
- 3. Insert the installer tool, bushing end first, into the distributor hole of on the engine block, and guide the bushing into the distributor drive hole.
- 4. Place the installer collar over the threaded shaft portion of the tool, and place it securely in the distributor hole.
- 5. Tap the end of the tool with a hammer to drive the bushing into the distributor drive hole until the flange is flush with the engine block.
- 6. Hand thread the large installation nut onto the threaded shaft until it is snug against the installer collar.
- 7. With a 3/8" wrench, hold the adjuster screw at the end of the tool. Simultaneously, with a 7/8" wrench tighten the large installation nut. This will pull the reamer tip through the newly installed bushing giving it a smooth line bore like finish.
- 8. Remove the tool from the engine.
- 9. The bushing is ready to accept a distributor shaft.
