- Every 3 months or 5000 miles check for loose hardware and tighten as necessary.

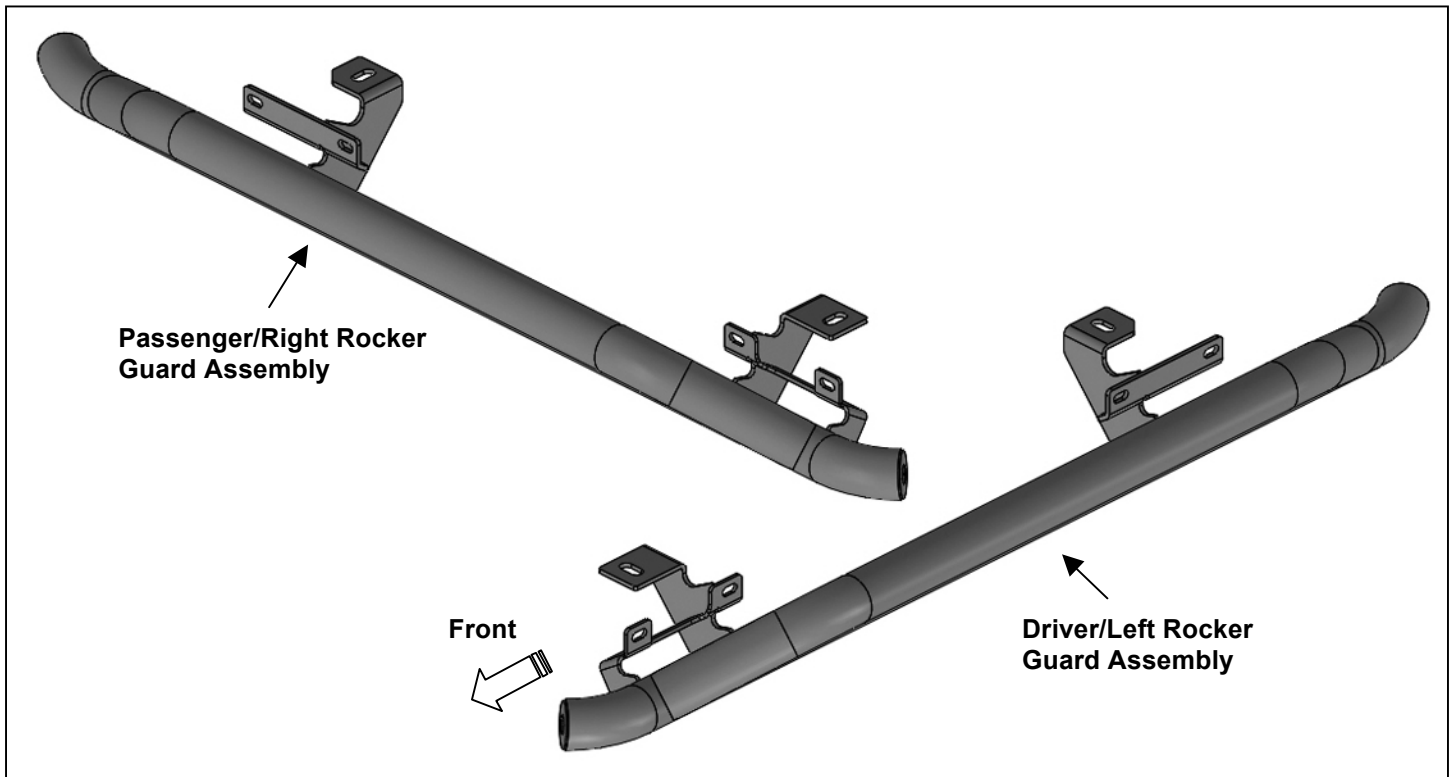

4	8mm Lock Washers	8	6mm Nylon Lock Nuts

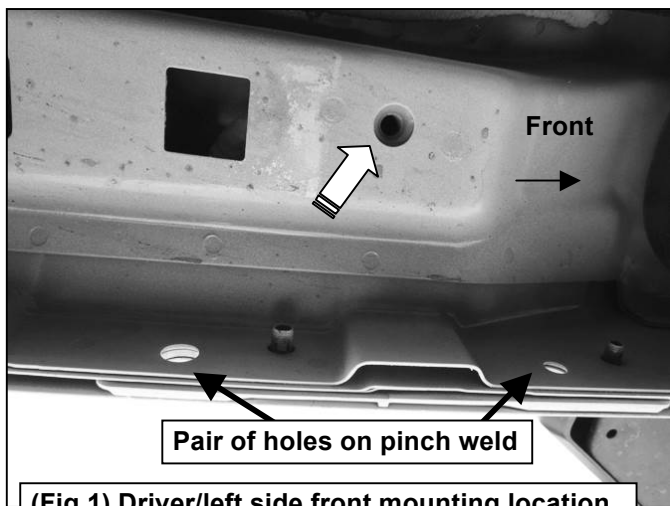


PROCEDURE:

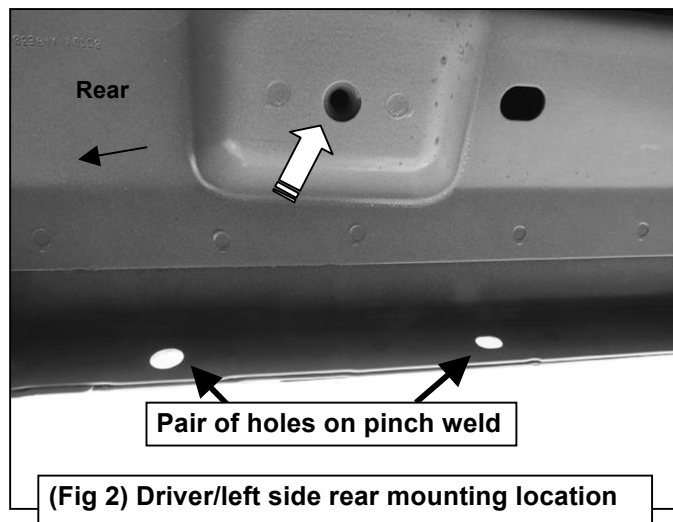
- 1. REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. FACTORY INSTALLED OR AFTERMARKET "ROCK RAILS," SIDE STEPS OR RUNNING BOARDS MUST BE REMOVED. ASSISTANCE IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.**

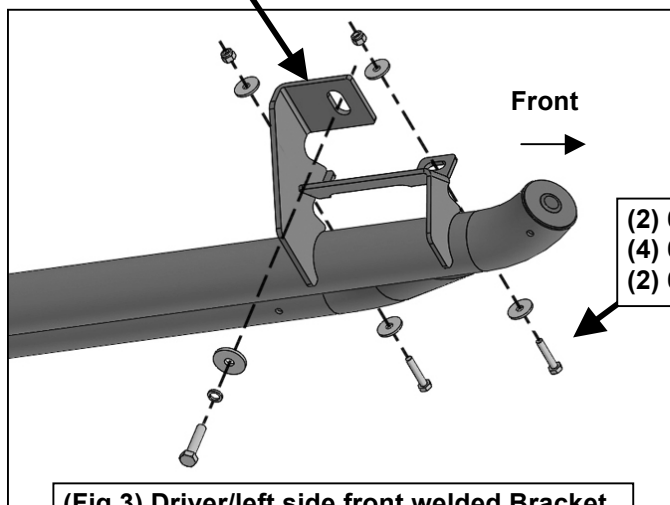


(Fig 1) Driver/left side front mounting location



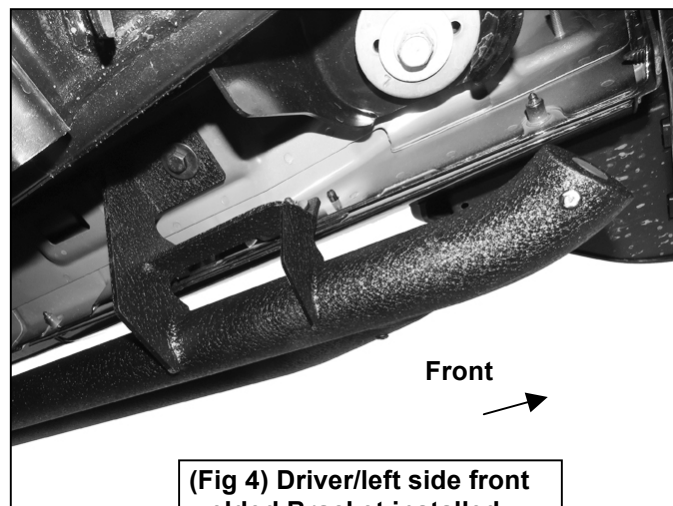
(Fig 2) Driver/left side rear mounting location

- Start installation on the driver side of the vehicle. Locate the (2) pairs of holes in the pinch weld. Directly behind each pair of holes, locate the 8mm threaded hole in the floor of the vehicle, (**Figures 1 & 2**). **NOTE:** Threaded holes may be covered with undercoating. Scrape off excess undercoating to provide a flat surface for brackets.

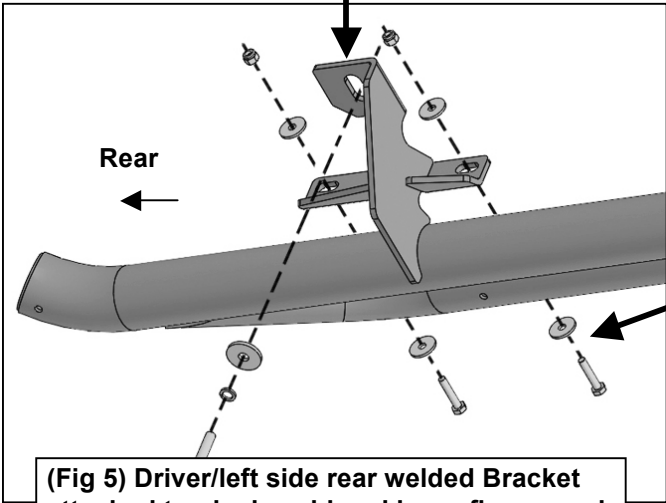
(Fig 3) Driver/left side front welded Bracket attached to pinch weld and inner floor panel

- With assistance, attach the Rocker Guard to the **back** of the pinch weld using the included (4) 6mm x 25mm Hex Bolts, (8) 6mm Flat Washers and (4) 6mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (**Figures 3—6**). Leave hardware loose at this time.
- Attach the mounting tabs on the Rocker Guard to the (2) threaded holes in the floor with the included (2) 8mm x 35mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (**Figures 3—6**).
- Adjust the Rocker Guard and tighten all hardware.
- Repeat **Steps 2—5** for passenger/right side Rocker Guard installation.
- Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

To protect your investment, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. Mild soap may be used to clean the Rocker Guard.

(Fig 4) Driver/left side front welded Bracket installed

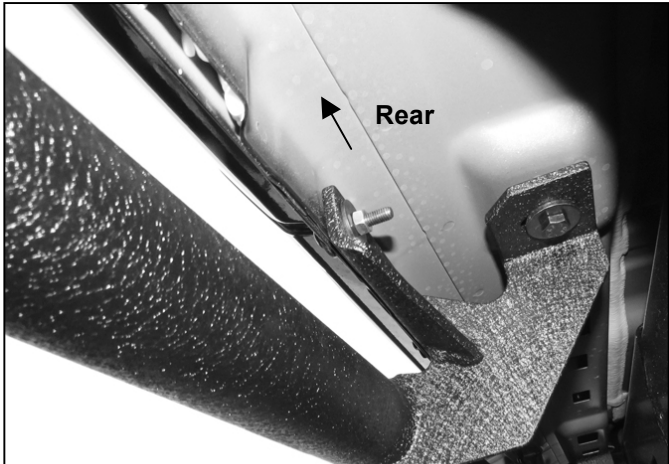
