



Read through entire installation manual and installation drawings to ensure that you understand all of the components and hardware before proceeding with installation.

NOTE: When installing the brackets, all hardware must be left loose until all of the items are attached.




BRACKET ORIENTATION



Insert each M8 U-Nut Clip into existing holes in rocker panel, making sure the treads are on the inside of the rocker panel.







1. Begin installation on passenger side. Position the Front Bracket, Center Bracket and Rear Bracket as shown in diagram.




2. Passenger Side Front, Center and Rear Bracket cradles (2a, 2b and 2c) will face towards the rear of the truck.






5. Fasten the bottom portion of the Passenger Side Front, Center and Rear Bracket by using (1) M8 x 30MM Hex Head Bolt, (1) M8 Flat Washer and (1) M8 Lock Washer.



6. Fasten the Running Board to the Passenger Side Front, Center and Rear Bracket cradles by using (2) M8 Flat Washers, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 Hex Head Nuts.




BRACKET ORIENTATION ON DIESEL MODEL WITH DEF TANK


NOTE: If installing on a diesel model with DEF tank, you must use Diesel Front/Center Upper/Lower Brackets on the passenger front and center mounting location.


6. Begin installation on passenger side. Position the Front/Center Upper Brackets and the Front/Center Lower Brackets and the Rear Bracket as shown in diagram.




7. Passenger Front/Center Lower Bracket cradles (7a and 7b) and Passenger Rear Bracket cradles (7c) will face towards the rear of the truck.

Passenger Side Center Lower Bracket








8. Slide Diesel Front/Center Upper Bracket between the DEF tank and the rocker panel (8a). The nut on this bracket will line up with the hole on the pinch weld and the vertical mounting point will be aligned with the threaded hole in the rocker panel (8b). If no threaded hole exists, please install M8 U-Nut Clip.




9. Fasten using (1) M8x 30MM Hex Head Bolt, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Flat Washer.



10. Next, hold the Diesel Front/Center Lower Bracket to the bottom of the pinch weld and attach to Diesel Front/Center Upper Bracket using (1) M10x 30MM Hex Head Bolt, (1) M10 Lock Washer (1) M10 Flat Washer.



11. Fasten the top portion of the Passenger Side Rear Bracket by using (1) M8 x 30MM Hex Head Bolt, (1) M8 Flat Washer and (1) M8 Lock Washer.








12. Fasten the bottom portion of the Passenger Side Front, Center and Rear Bracket by using (1) M8 x 30MM Hex Head Bolt, (1) M8 Flat Washer and (1) M8 Lock Washer.



13. Fasten the Running Board to the Passenger Side Front/Center Lower Bracket cradles by using (2) M8 Flat Washers, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 Hex Head Nuts.



14. Fasten the Running Board to the Passenger Side Rear Bracket cradles by using (2) M8 Flat Washers, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 Hex Head Nuts.






6.5" SAWTOOTH RUNNING BOARD

ADAPTER PLATE INSTALLATION



1. Flip Running Board over. Place each Backing Plate and each Bolt Adapter Plate together (1a) and place onto underside of the running board and through the notch (1b). Slide plates into channels of running board and position plates so they line up approximately with existing mounting bracket location (1c).

Note: It might be helpful to position the underside of running board parallel to the existing mounting plates already installed on your vehicle, so you can align the Backing Plate/Bolt Adapter more accurately.





2. You may need to adjust the plates slightly to align with the existing brackets (2a). Once aligned, insert provided allen drive studs into the holes on the Bolt Adapter Plate (2b), and finger tighten to hold both plates securely in place (2c), while still allowing for further adjustment to match up with vehicle mounting brackets. Repeat steps 1 and 2 for passenger side.






- 3. Tighten allen drive studs with allen wrench (3a). Place Running Board on brackets (3b). Each running board is marked Driver and Passenger.
- 4. Align each allen drive stud with each hole in the bracket. Place the spacer plate in between the bracket and the board when installing.
- 5. Fasten Running Board on each bracket by using two (2) M8 Flat Washers, two (2) M8 Lock Washers and two (2) M8 Hex Head Nuts per bracket.

When all hardware is in place, everything must be tightened. Tighten until the split lock washer is flat between the M8 Flat Washer and M8 Hex Head Nut.

Repeat these steps for driver side installation.
