- ALWAYS step on treaded surface of hitch step




Place a small amount of heavy oil or grease on ball before each use.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Insert shank into hitch receiver and attach pin & clip (sold separately).
- 2. Insert tri-ball assembly onto the shank, adjust to proper height and attach shank pin & clip. (Height adjustment is in increments of 1.25 inches.)
- 3. Remove spindle pin & clip, rotate to select ball size or step, and reinstall spindle pin & clip.

Note: See Figure 1 for maximum drop position and Figure 2 for maximum rise position.




Figure 5: Proper Ball Height

Note: Check for proper ball mount height with vehicle and trailer loaded for travel. At proper adjustment the trailer coupler and tongue should be level with the ground. See Figure 5.
