## E-brake Handle

Check to make sure that you have all parts listed prior to installation. If anything is missing contact us immediately.

Step 1 - If your car does not have an integrated E-brake handle boot, skip to step 2. Using a razor blade, cut all the way around the factory seam as shown in photo 1

Step 2 - Un-thread button and pull leather handle off E-brake housing as shown in photo 2. (If leather handle seems stuck, use a hair drier to soften up the glue connecting it to the e-brake handle shaft.

Parts List: (1) E-brake handle

(1) Button

(2) 6-32x3/16 set screw - MC92311A143

(1) Boot Bezel \*\*Some models

(1) Allen Key MC7122a14

Step  $\bf 3$  - Install boot bezel (only cars with integrated boot ) and thread on aluminum button as shown in photo  $\bf 3$ .

Step 4 - Install aluminum handle, rotate handle so set screws are pointing down. Tighten set screws.
