Roof Allowance:


Total permissible weight attached to the roof of the car. This is inclusive of the weight of the roof rack system Cargo Allowance: Total permissible weight allowed on top, and attached to roof racks whilst the vehicle is in motion Please refer to your vehicle manufacturers handbook for maximum carrying capacity. Always use the lower of the two figures. Load must be evenly distributed over the entire Pioneer. Weight of roof rack accessories is to be included in cargo allowance.

Torque settings


Unless stated otherwise in these instructions, all fasteners should be set to the following torque settings -M6: 4-5Nm (3-4lbs/ft), M8: 8-10Nm (6-7.5lbs/ft) and M10: 16-18Nm (12-13lbs/ft).

Warning:

- Check Part No. and/ or Kit is correct for use with your vehicle
- Do not attempt to fit the rack system to your vehicle unless you fully understand these fitting instructions. Please direct any guestions regarding fitting to the dealer from where the roof racks were purchased.
- Use only non-stretch fastening ropes or straps.
- The handling characteristics of the vehicle changes when you transport a load on the roof. For safety reasons we recommend you exercise extreme care when transporting wind-resistant loads. Special consideration must be taken into account when cornering and braking
- Although the system is tested and approved to AS1235-2000 / ISO 11154, off-road conditions can be much more rigorous. Extreme care must be taken in off road conditions





