



Roll Bar Storage Bag

Fits: Wrangler JL & JK (2-door & 4-door), TJ, LJ, YJ, CJ, Gladiator JT

The correct attachment of this product is critical and beyond the control of Rightline Gear. The safe use and long life of this product depends entirely on your good judgment and following these directions.

Pack The Roll Bar Storage Bag

1-Because of the waterproof design of the SZIP zipper, it may be necessary to apply a small amount of lubricant to the outer surface of the zipper to allow it to slide freely (Fig 1). Suitable lubricants are bearing grease, petroleum jelly, or similar grease type products.



2-Place items like recovery gear, clothing, towels, first aid kits, road side equipment, snacks, etc. in the Roll Bar Storage Bag (Fig 2).



Attach The Roll Bar Storage Bag

1-Position the bag so that its zipper pull holder is located at the top of the bag (Fig 2).

2-Wrap the bottom strap around the roll bar without twisting the strap. Thread the strap up through the middle slot and down through the front slot of the buckle (Fig 3).



3-Wrap the top strap around the roll bar without twisting the strap. Thread the strap up through the middle slot and down through the front slot of the buckle (Fig 4).



NOTE: IF ATTACHING THE ROLL BAR STORAGE BAG TO AN UNCOVERED ROLL BAR, POSITION THE SMALL LEATHER STRAP PIECES UNDER THE LADDER BUCKLES TO PROTECT IT (FIG 5).



4-Stretch the bag along the roll bar and tighten both straps (Fig 6).

5-Adjust the elastic strap pieces to hold the loose ends of the straps (Fig 7).



CAUTION: MAKE SURE THAT THE SEAT BELTS CAN MOVE UNRESTRICTED BEFORE OPERATING THE VEHICLE.
