INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Remove factory fog light and housing by unscrewing three 8mm bolts. As shown in Figure #1.
- 2. Remove factory fog light from housing assembly as shown in Figure #2.
- 3. Install bracket on D-Series light using hardware provided with light.
- 4. Attach bracket with D-Series light onto housing assembly utilizing the factory clip, spring and adjuster bolt. Use provided plastic spacers between outside edge of bracket and inside edge of housing assembly.

- (Cont'd) Insert the stainless steel spacer between the bracket and factory plastic clip on the bottom of the bracket (spacer just adds thickness to match clip). As shown in Figure #3.
- 5. Re-install fog light assembly with D-Series light onto vehicle.
- 6. Wire your lights according to the instructions included with the light(s). Take care to avoid any heat sources and sharp or abrasive surfaces.

Your installation is now complete.
