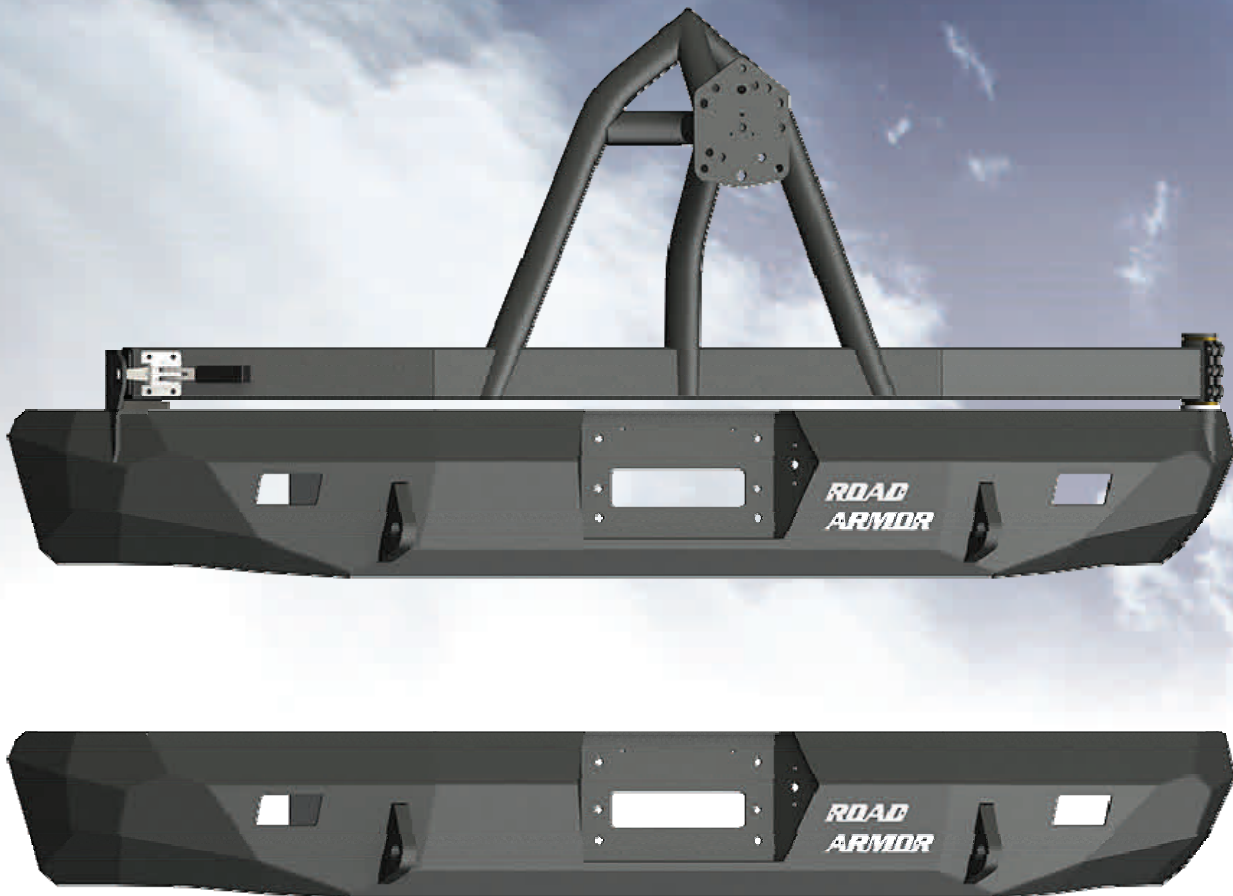

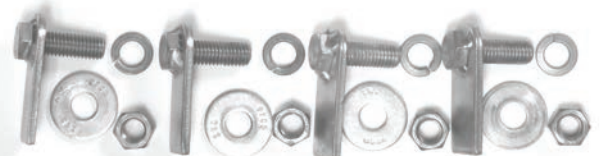
SAE & Metric Sockets and Wrenches

9/16" Drill Bit or step bit

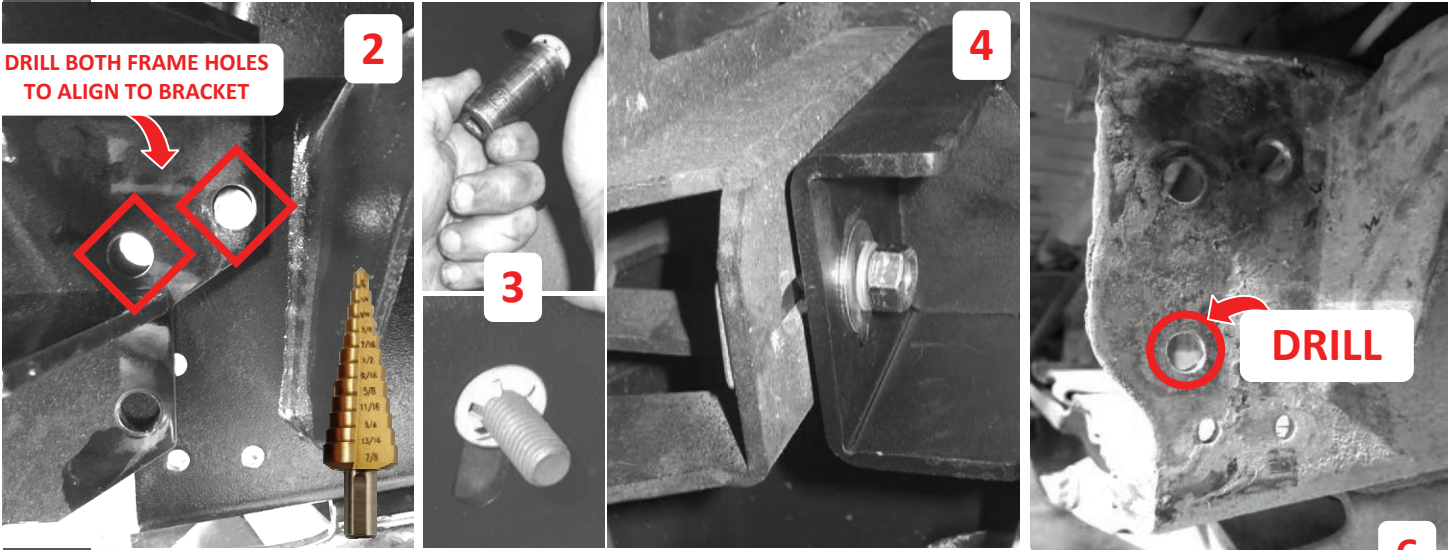


**INCLUDED HARDWARE**

- 4 1.5" SINGLE BOLT TAB (ZINC)
- 6 1.5" x 1/2"-13 Bolts
- 16 1/2" Flat Washer
- 10 1/2" Split Lock Washer
- 10 1/2"-13 Grade 8 Hex Nut
- 1 Stainless Logo & Bolt Kit
- 2 License Plate Lights & hardware



- 1 Remove factory bumper and set aside.
- 2 On some models the bolt pattern here is off. To alleviate this, using a step bit, open both holes until the bracket will bolt on. This also adds some rotational adjustment. Touch up the bare steel with spray paint.



- 3 Push on one retainer washer over bolt plate each side.
- 4 Now fit up the bumper to the brackets using the single bolt tabs and snug but don't tighten. This allows you to adjust the rotation, side to side as well as up and down a little.
- 5 Once satisfied with fitment, tighten up the brackets and bumper to brackets.
- 6 Now drill the third bracket hole through the bracket and touch up with spray paint, then tighten the final bolt in place to secure the bracket to frame.
- 7 If you have the tire carrier version, please attach as shown.
- 8 Stainless button head bolts are for logo, tapered bolts are for license plate lights. Installation of license plate lights is done at your discretion.
